



\$60 MILLION HOSPITAL EXPANSION (01/07)

Schneck Medical Center in Seymour, Indiana is under way with its \$60 Million renovation and expansion, and new state-of-the-art cancer center.

Just like its motto, "Better Healthcare Begins Here," Schneck Medical Center is on its way to better serving the community by moving closer to a better-equipped facility.

"Right now we're working on the expansion building and also doing renovations inside," Stephanie Furlow, marketing and public relations director of Schneck Medical Center, said early this month.

"Probably the first part of March, we'll open our newly renovated private rooms and we'll continue the renovations until May of 2008," she added.

Furlow also said in place of the 1941 building that was demolished, there would be a "fill-in" building that will basically fill the gap and house endoscopy, the pain center, infusion therapy, cardiology rehabilitation and same-day surgery.

It will be connected to the expansion, she said, and will open with the rest of the expansion in May 2008.
