



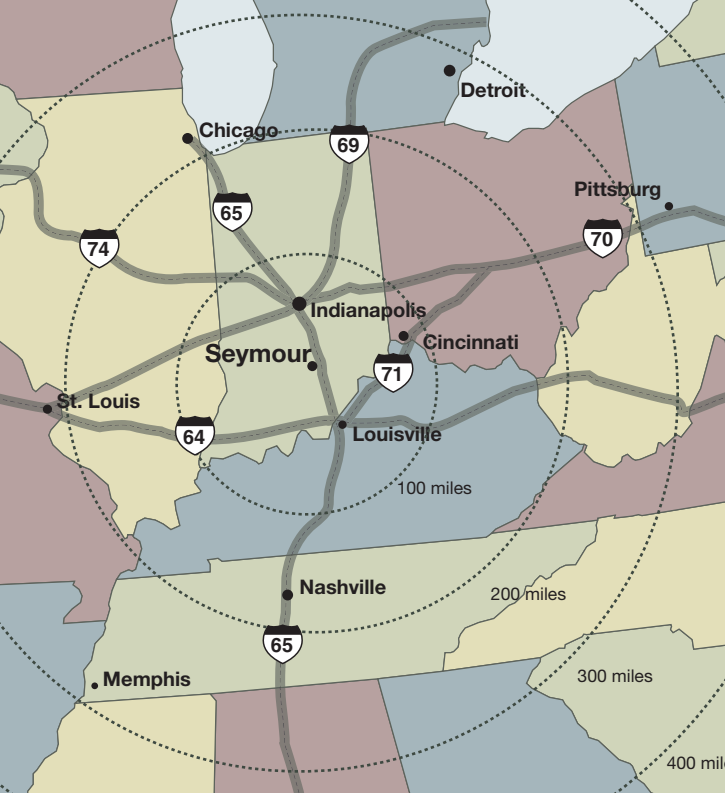

Located along Interstate 65, Jackson County is 60 miles south of Indianapolis, Indiana, 50 miles north of Louisville, Kentucky and 90 miles west of Cincinnati, Ohio. Chicago, St. Louis, Detroit and Memphis are also within a 300 mile radius.

I-65 as well as U.S. highways 50 and 31 allow easy access to three major international airports, and hubs for major carriers such as FedEx and UPS. Rail transportation can be accessed in Jackson County via dual rail lines, and water transportation is less than an hour south on the Ohio River through Clark Maritime Center. Seymour's Freeman Field Municipal Airport, with its 5,500 foot runways, is available for cargo and charter service.

Simply put, when it comes to access, Seymour-Jackson County offers more of the roads most traveled.
